Thank you for considering making a gift with the ELCA Foundation that will help ELCA ministries do God's work in Christ's name for the life of the world. We know you support ELCA ministries because you believe in what they do, and because you have a desire and passion to change the world. But we'd like to make sure you benefit from giving with the ELCA Foundation.

How does this happen? You may be surprised to learn that many gift types offer significant financial and tax benefits.

YOU HAVE OPTIONS

You may be familiar with outright gifts, such as cash or a check, which you make today and can be used right away. But sometimes an immediate gift isn't the best option, especially if you feel unsure about giving up assets today that you and your loved ones might need in the future.

A planned gift is a perfect solution. There are many different types of planned gifts, and each

offers unique advantages. Some planned gifts are revocable—a gift in your will or living trust, for example—so you can change your mind at any time.

Or they can be irrevocable—just as outright gifts are—so that you benefit from an immediate tax deduction.

Irrevocable planned gifts are attractive because they are deferred. You part with an asset today, but the allocation to a ministry is put off for a while—often until after your lifetime (and that of a surviving beneficiary, if you wish). Until that time, you enjoy the benefits from the gift.

For example, with a charitable remainder trust, you receive lifetime income from the asset after it's placed in a trust, and then our ministries receive the remainder of the trust after your lifetime. Or you could deed us a remainder interest in your home and still retain the right to live in it for life.

The key feature of planned gifts such as these is that they provide important benefits to you as well as the work of the ELCA.

Donor-advised Fund	Create a charitable account that is professionally managed and administered by the ELCA Foundation while providing input on its distributions to ministries.	 Establish and name a DAF with the ELCA Foundation through your work with a regional gift planner. You can make contributions to your fund at any time. Your contributions are invested by us, which provides a regular accounting to you. 	 Distribute gifts by your recommendation. Qualify for an income tax deduction in the year you make your gift. Watch your contributions grow tax-free.
Donor-directed Distribution Agreement	Simplify your charitable estate gifts to ELCA-related ministries and other nonprofits.	 Establish your distribution agreement naming the recipients of your gift, and any restrictions, with the ELCA Foundation. Direct your gifts to the ELCA Foundation through a will, trust and/or beneficiary designation. 	 Update your charitable beneficiaries without updating your will, trust or beneficiary designations. The ELCA Foundation partners in distributing gifts, and communicating donor intent, for your estate.
Named Endowment Funds	Establish an endowment fund in your name or in memory of a loved one, providing perpetual support to the ministries that matter the most to you.	Through your work with an ELCA regional gift planner, you can establish a named endowment fund with an immediate gift, with a multiyear gift commitment and/or through your estate plan.	 Leave a legacy in your name or in memory of a loved one. Qualify for an income tax deduction for each gift you contribute to the endowment.
Charitable Gift Annuity* Charitable Remainder Trust	Support ELCA-related ministries and boost your own retirement income (or someone else's if you choose).	Depending on the gift arrangement, you can receive either fixed or variable payments for life in exchange for a gift of cash or securities. After the term ends, the balance is used to support ELCA ministries.	 Qualify for an income tax deduction for the charitable portion of your gift. Receive capital gains tax savings when you transfer appreciated property. Receive income for life for you or someone else if you choose. Support ELCA ministries with the remaining balance after the term ends.

*California residents: Annuities are subject to regulation by the State of California.
